

To reduce the password security in Windows 2008, follow these steps:

1. Start the Control Panel, open Administrative Tools, start Group Policy manager
2. Open the Default Domain, click on the Settings tab in the right pane, right click in that pane and choose Edit.
3. Navigate in the left pane to Policies, then Windows Settings, then Security Settings, then Password Policy. Open the policy in the right pane and set the value to 0 and enable the policy.
4. Close the Group Policy manager, start a CMD prompt and type gpupdate.msc /force
5. The policy should update and be in effect.
